NOTES ON A GREEN NEW YEAR THEME

Happy New Year everyone!

So.... all the presents have been unwrapped and the wrapping paper is in the bin.

The Christmas trees have been de-decked and the trees thrown out in the cold. The surplus food made into soups or put into the food waste boxes. And we have packed Christmas away until next year.

Did you know that the Christmas tree collections started this week; running from 6 - 17 January with trees being picked up on your normal garden waste pick up days. We also learnt that, if only we lived near an alpaca farm we could take our trees there because alpacas love eating Christmas trees and they are really good for their guts!!

Christmas wrapping paper can be recycled as long as it is not foiled or glittered and you have taken the cellulose tape off before depositing it in your bins.

Food waste is collected in our borough and turned into energy and fertilisers. If you haven't got a food caddy or need a new one you can get one from by going on to the council website. Free compostable food bin liners can be picked up from the library or Twickenham Civic Centre.

Coffee and hot chocolate pods can be recycled free of charge at the Townmead Road Reuse and Recycling Centre who are in partnership with Podback, a non-profit recycling service created and funded by the UK's leading coffee pod systems and over 25 coffee pod brands and national retailers. Plastic and aluminium pods need to be collected separately, as they are recycled at different facilities. Simply collect them at home in a reusable bag and, when ready, book a time slot at the centre to take them there.
